#### Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> April DIARY OF A HOUSEWIFE 1945-1948






#### SWIMMING

It's hard to believe that it is only 14 months ago since the devastating floods of "Storm Desmond" hit the area. It caused wide spread flooding and prolonged power cuts. Hopefully similar events will be infrequent but it would be

wise to prepare for the worst.

We are developing a **Community Emergency Plan** for Borwick and Priest Hutton which will be published in the near future. This will provide a centralised support network based at the village hall, triggered in the event of an emergency.

Meanwhile every resident can help themselves by making up a **"Home Emergency Pack"**. These items should be placed in a carton or box and stored somewhere easily accessible.
