St Mary's Church, Borwick is moving towards Net Zero but needs your help.

At St Mary's we have been running an appeal to raise £2,500 to replace the old, inefficient and expensive to run lighting with modern, low energy LED lights. So far we have raised just over £1,700 including Gift Aid and now just need a final push to get us over the finishing line. We are hoping to have the LED lamps installed in June...

Much of the £1,700 was received in support of our new vicar, Alice's, heroic and successful running of the Manchester Marathon.

On 16th June, Joyce Tombs will be attempting the Cross Bay walk from Arnside to Grange - not exactly a marathon but, at 8 miles and 4 hours over wet sand, still quite a challenge for an OAP! So Joyce would be extremely grateful if you would like to show your support by contributing to the St Mary's LED Lighting Project.

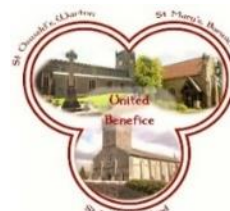
